

Northeastern University Provides Community College Faculty/Staff with Scholarships

Boston, MA – December 8th, 2015 - Northeastern University's College of Professional Studies (CPS) has partnered with the Massachusetts Community Colleges Executive Office (MCCEO) to offer faculty and staff of the 15 community colleges in the Commonwealth scholarships to pursue continuing educational opportunities in bachelor's and master's degree programs at CPS, as well as the CPS Doctor of Education program.

The partnership will be referred to as the Community College Faculty/Staff Scholarship Program at Northeastern University's College of Professional Studies and equates to a 25 percent reduction of the per credit tuition charge for up to seven years. In addition to the scholarship opportunity, application fees will be waived for community college faculty and staff applying for admittance in CPS degree and certificate programs. Community college faculty and staff will still need to meet all admissions requirements to be accepted into the competitive programs and additional merit and need-based aid may be offered upon acceptance. Designated staff members will be named on each community college campus shortly and will be able to provide additional information about the Scholarship Program and application procedures.
